**Could you?**

Your 2 year old could be getting 15 hours a week of funded early education and childcare if you are in receipt of one of the following benefits or credits

- Child Tax Credit and have an annual income not over £16,190
- Working Tax Credits and earn no more than £16,190 a year
- If your child is in receipt of Disability Living Allowance (DLA)
- Universal Credit and have an income of no more than £15,400, assessed on 3 most recent periods
- If your child has an Education Health and Care Plan

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

- Children who are Looked After by the Local Authority
- Children who have left care through an adoption order, residence order or special guardianship.
