This is an important opportunity for us to focus collectively on improving outcomes for disadvantaged learners and learning will be shared from within and beyond the county. There is a strong focus on leadership this year and there will be structured opportunities throughout the day for all North Yorkshire school leaders to share effective strategies aligned to evidence based practice. Feedback on priorities arising from the conference activities will also inform our county wide strategy for disadvantaged learners moving forward. We are very pleased to have a number of national leaders in education from outside the county working with us on the day and the UCL Institute of Education - leading researchers on social mobility and disadvantage. Conference activities, including the workshops, will share practice from within North Yorkshire schools and beyond. We will also be joined by Marc Rowland, Head of the London research school who continues to support our work with schools across the county.
