#### **Complex Case Progression meetings**

#### **Audience: All Schools**

The Local authority have recently established Complex Case Progression meetings across the county in order to ensure a co-ordinated response for vulnerable children and young people who are not receiving suitable full time education. It is the duty of the LA to identify all children in this position, and to make every effort to ensure their needs are met.

The core purpose of the CCP meetings is to provide a forum for discussion of children who are, for whatever reason, not accessing a full time education at present, and to develop a coordinated response across services to facilitate and improve access to and engagement in education in partnership with schools. If necessary the meeting will be able to instigate support and challenge to education settings, families and young people.

The child or young person's school may be asked to share information relating to a child or young person identified as not receiving suitable full time provision in order to jointly plan an appropriate response to ensuring the needs of the pupils are effectively supported.

#### The Energy Check

#### Audience: All LA Schools

The Energy traded service have become aware that several schools have been contacted by a company called The Energy Check. They are calling the schools, then following up with an email that says:

As discussed earlier I will be undertaking a check with your DNO and Electricity Supplier to determine whether your kVA capacity has been set correctly. The electricity meter will need a check based on the usage from the substation, this would have been predicted by the electrician or electrical engineer when the meter was installed however post installation usage is never recorded and as such you may be being overcharged for capacity you aren't using or you may be exposed to penalty charges under the DCP161 Regulation which comes into force in April 2018 for over-using.

Please be advised that if your school is on the NYCC Electricity supply contract, the Energy traded service have already carried out this check on your behalf. If any action was required for your supply we have taken care of it.
