Concerto Property Management System - Support	
<p><b>Audience: All Schools</b></p> <p>Support for <a href="#">Concerto</a>, NYCC's Property Management system , is moving from the property service to the corporate systems team in Technology and Change (T&amp;C) from 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2018. SEND Transport Decision / Enhanced Parental Transport Allowance	
<p><b>Audience: all schools</b></p> <p>Following a decision on the 16th May 2018 the revised home to school transport policy was approved by Full Council. However it was agreed that the enhanced parental transport allowance would be subject to a further 30 day consultation to provide more information for parents/carers on how the allowance would be calculated. The consultation was held between 18 June 2018 and 13 July 2018 and attracted feedback from 17 respondents. The outcomes of the consultation were considered by the Corporate Director for Children and Young People's Service and the lead Executive Member and a final decision made on 24th July.</p> <p>It was agreed that the Enhanced Parental Transport Allowance will be implemented following consultation on the proposed methodology to take account of individual circumstances. The allowance will only be available to solo travellers with an Education, Health and Care Plan and is a voluntary agreement with families.
