<p>Positive Behaviour Approaches, De-escalation Techniques and Safe Holding Principles 90-minute remote (via TEAMS) training, including advice, strategies and tools to develop positive outcomes for children and young people.</p>	<p><i>This de-escalation training offer is identical to that currently being offered by the Local Authority (via NYES) and worth over £300 (based on a 90 to 120-minute twilight session).</i></p> <p>By the end of the session, you and your team should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be clear about the causes of and reasons for escalating behaviour • aware of de-escalation strategies that can be used with pupils • know about the ‘reasonable adjustments’ and other factors that promote positive behaviour and relationships • feel more confident and competent to intervene positively • have an understanding of the legal context for physical intervention and how to fulfil your duty of care to all children, young people and adults 	<p><i>This is NOT Restrictive Physical Intervention training. However, this training WILL support you to de-escalate situations involving dysregulated pupils and will give you clear guidance on statutory information relating to physical intervention.</i></p> <p><i>It is recommended that all schools and settings take up the opportunity to attend this training, especially if they have not undertaken similar training within the past two years. Staff teams can access the training as well as individuals.</i></p>
