

FREE Poverty Awareness Training for North Yorkshire Schools

Poverty has a significant impact on communities across the UK, with over 14 million people affected by poverty, including 71% of working households and 42% of families with three or more children particularly affected. The training is designed to leave a lasting impact and to get participants feeling curious and galvanised to make inclusive change.

This free training session funded by public health will provide schools with an opportunity to

- To understand how poverty is defined
- To have an awareness of child poverty statistics in a national and local context
- To understand who is most at risk of poverty
- To understand the causes of poverty and how it impacts decision making
- To understand the link between child poverty and education
- To understand how practices in your school can create barriers for those living in poverty and to start to consider the solutions
