The immunisations currently being given to teenagers in schools are:

HPV

The HPV vaccine helps protect against cancers caused by Human Papilloma Virus, including cervical cancer; some mouth and throat (head and neck) cancers; some cancers of the anal and genital areas; It also helps protect against genital warts.

3 in 1 teenage booster

The 3 in 1 teenage booster protects against Diphtheria, Tetanus and Polio, this vaccine is given at the same time as Men ACWY,
