


CHILDMINDERS

WHAT TO DO IF: YOU HAVE CHILD PROTECTION CONCERNS; AN ALLEGATION IS MADE AGAINST A PERSON WORKING WITH CHILDREN.



Referral to Children and Families Service If you consider that a referral needs to be made to the Children and Families Service you should contact the Customer Screening Team on 01609 780780 and then follow your referral up in writing. http://cyps.northyorks.gov.uk/referral-forms

Outside of office hours you should call the Emergency Duty Team 01609 780780 The referrer should:

- $_{\hbox{\scriptsize \square}}$ State why they are concerned and any current issues suggesting immediate risk of harm
- $_{\square}$ Share their knowledge of the child(ren) and family and any other agency involved
- ☐ State if the child's parent's/carer's are aware of the referral and their expectations
- Record their concerns and actions and follow the referral up in writing within 48 hours (see attached)
- Π Give details of where they can be contacted that day.

<u>Advice</u> If you have child protection concerns i.e. you consider that a child is suffering or is likely to suffer significant harm, please call the numbers above.

If you wish, discuss your concerns with and seek advice

<u>Allegations against childminders including assistants/volunteers who work with</u> children:

In the event of an allegation being made against a person who works with children that they have:

- Behaved in a way that has harmed or may have harmed a child
- Possibly committed a criminal offence against or related to a child
- Behaves towards a child or children in a way that indicates s/he would pose a risk of harm to children

In the first instance you should contact the Duty LADO by telephone on 01609 532477.

Ofsted should be informed of: any significant event which is likely to affect suitability to care for children; any allegation of serious harm or abuse by a person looking after children, whether that be on the premises or elsewhere: **0300 1231231 or 0300 123 4666**

<u>Child subject to a Child Protection Plan</u>: As a professional you should be made aware if a child in your setting is subject to a child protection plan. If you have not and suspect that this may be the case you can call the Children's Database Enquiry Line. **01609 536462**. If the child is subject to a

CP plan or is an open case to Children's Social Care you will be given information and the name and contact number of the social worker who is assigned the case.
