
# Craven

## **Locality - performance summary**



# **Headlines – Craven Schools Locality**

#### **Exclusions from school**

- As of the end of December there had been a total of 1542 fixed-term exclusions from mainstream schools in North Yorkshire in 2020/21. 77 (5%) of these occurred in mainstream schools in Craven, 11.2% occurred in Craven in the same period last year.
- Fixed-term exclusions are down (-35%) compared to the same period in North Yorkshire in 2019/20 (2386). There were also 35% fewer fixed-term exclusions in Craven, compared to same period in 2019/20 (118).
- To the end of December in 2020/21, there has been 1 permanent exclusion from Craven mainstream schools or 7% of the North Yorkshire total of 14.
- In the same period last year, permanent exclusions from Craven mainstream schools represented 8% of the North Yorkshire total (2 of 26).

#### **Attendance**

- The proportion of children in attendance in schools in Craven decreased over the Winter term. Between November and the end of December, attendance was down in Secondary schools (from 91.0% to 87.0%) and down in primary schools (from 93.5% to 91.7%)
- As of 17<sup>th</sup> December 2020 there were 568 children recorded as being absent from mainstream schools in Craven for unauthorised absence or absence related to Covid-19, 12.9% of the 4406 recorded in North Yorkshire mainstream schools
- 456 (80.2%) were absent for reasons of Covid-19 in the locality, the North Yorkshire total was 3371 (76.5%)
- Since the 4<sup>th</sup> January 2021 announcement of the closure of schools, this data will be reviewed and will be presented in future reports

#### **Elective Home Education (EHE)**

- As of the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 there were 808 children recorded as Electively Home Educated in North Yorkshire, a 30% increase on the same point last year (621). The total increase for children formerly from a Craven mainstream school has been 40% in the same period (48 to 67)
- The rate of children Educated at Home of the mainstream school population in Craven is 0.76%, as of December 2020, which is much lower than the rate of EHE for the mainstream school population for North Yorkshire (0.99%)
- There have been increases in EHE across all school localities in this period


#### SEN in mainstream schools

- 9.7% of children in Craven schools were recorded as having special educational needs in the January 2020 school census, a similar rate to the North Yorkshire rate as a whole of 12.7%
- The rate of children recorded as SEN Support in the locality was 8.2% of the mainstream school population, much lower than the average North Yorkshire rate of 11.2%
- The EHC plan rate of the school population (1.5%) is the same as the North Yorkshire rate of 1.5%

#### **Ofsted Outcomes**

 As of November 2020, the rate of primary schools with a 'Good' or 'Outstanding' outcome in the locality at the most recent Ofsted inspection was 83.9%, higher than the North Yorkshire average of 82.0%.
 However, the secondary school rate was 83.3%, considerably above the county rate of 74.4%

# **SEN Population in Schools**




Proportion of mainstream school population with SEN provision (by type of provision) in North Yorkshire and Craven school locality

- 9.7% of children in Craven schools recorded as SEN in 2019, well below the rate in North Yorkshire as a whole (12.7%).
- 9.7% is a 0.8 percentage point increase in SEN compared to 2019.
- 1.5% of the Craven school population have an Education, Health and Care plan (EHCp) the same as the North Yorkshire rate of 1.5%.
- 8.2% of the Craven school population are recorded as SEN Support well below the North Yorkshire rate of 11.2%.

- The SEN Support rate (8.2%) of the school population in Craven is the lowest of the five localities
- The EHC plan rate (1.5%) is the same as the North Yorkshire average

## **Requests for Assessment**




Requests for assessment (EHC plan) based on the mainstream school locality of child - North Yorkshire total received - by year academic year

- There were a total of 684 requests for statutory assessment received by North Yorkshire County Council in 2019/20, 38 (5.2%) were received for children in mainstream schools in Craven.
- Each of the above figures are similar to last year's rates.
   Approximately 4% of the 714 requests received by NYCC in 2018/19 were for children in mainstream schools in Craven.
- 51% of requests for assessment from Craven schools in 2019/20 resulted in an EHC plan, a lower rate than the North Yorkshire average of 64%. A proportion of requests received in the 2020 calendar year are yet to be assessed, current comparisons with previous years are not yet available.
- 38 requests is 0.43% of the mainstream school population which is lower than the North Yorkshire rate of 0.67%. It is also the lowest rate of the five school localities.






% of children in schools in North Yorkshire and Craven locality achieving a Good Level of Development (% GLD) for the SEN cohort and the entire cohort

- 72.3% of children in Craven schools achieved a good level of development in 2018/19, a -0.5 percentage point difference from the North Yorkshire rate. This was a 0.4 percentage point increase on the previous year (71.9% in 2017/18).
- 10.7% of the SEN cohort (children recorded with EHC plans or SEN Support) in Craven schools achieved a good level of development in 2018/19 which was a 2.6 percentage point increase on the previous year but a lower rate than North Yorkshire as a whole (21.5%).





Average Attainment 8 scores at Key Stage 4 in schools in North Yorkshire and Craven locality for the SEN cohort and the entire cohort

- 61.8% of children in Craven schools achieved the expected standard for reading, writing and maths (%RWM) in 2018/19, this was a 0.4 percentage point decrease on the previous year.
- 11.8% of the SEN cohort (children recorded with EHC plans or SEN Support) in Craven schools achieved the expected standard for reading, writing and maths in 2018/19 which was a 2.2 percentage point drop on the previous year. This was also a lower rate than North Yorkshire as a whole (18.1%).
- The average Attainment 8 score for children in schools in the Craven locality was 53.4 in 2018/19, a 2.9 percentage point increase on the previous year and higher than the average score for North Yorkshire (48.6).
- The average Attainment 8 score for children with SEN in Craven schools was 36.8 up by 8.3 on the previous year and considerably above the North Yorkshire average score of 26.8.

### **Fixed-term Exclusions**




% of children fixed-term excluded at least once in schools in primary and secondary schools in North Yorkshire and Craven locality in the 2019/20 and 2018/19 academic years.

#### **Primary Schools**

- 0.12% of pupils (a total of 11 pupils) in Craven primary schools were fixed period excluded at least once in the 2019/20 academic year, which was lower than the North Yorkshire primary school rate (0.38%).
- There were a total of 27 fixed-period exclusions in Craven primary schools in 2019/20, an 80% increase on the previous year (15 exclusions). Fixed-period exclusions from Craven primary schools formed 6.4% of the North Yorkshire total (425) in 2019/20.

#### **Secondary Schools**


 2.29% of pupils (a total of 103 pupils) in Craven secondary schools were fixed period excluded at least once in the 2019/20 academic year, which was a lower rate than the North Yorkshire secondary school rate (3.6%).
 Children fixed-period excluded from Craven secondary schools formed 7.9% of the total for children fixed-period excluded from secondary schools in North Yorkshire in 2019/20.




Fixed-Term exclusions in North Yorkshire mainstream schools (Primary and Secondary) - 2018/19 and 2019/20 to end November

- As of the end of December there were a total of 1542 fixed-term exclusions from mainstream schools in North Yorkshire in 2020/21. 77 (4.9%) of these occurred in mainstream schools in Craven, 5.0% occurred in Craven in the same period last year.
- There were 55% more fixed-term exclusions in the same period in North Yorkshire in 2019/20 (2386). There were 53% more in Craven in the same period (118).

#### **Permanent Exclusions**






Permanent exclusions in primary and secondary schools in North Yorkshire and Craven locality

- There was 1 permanent exclusion from Craven primary schools in the 2019/20 academic year, the North Yorkshire total was 6. In 2018/19 there was also 1 permanent exclusion from Craven primary schools but there were none in 2017/18.
- There were a total of 2 permanent exclusions from Craven secondary schools in the 2019/20 academic year, 4.4% of the North Yorkshire total (46). This is the same number as the previous year, in 2018/19 there were a total of 2 permanent exclusions from Craven secondary schools.
- To the end of December in 2020/21, there has been 1 permanent exclusions from Craven secondary schools, there had been 1 at the same point in 2019/20 and 1 from primary schools.
- The North Yorkshire total of permanent exclusions in mainstream schools in 2020/21 to end December 2020 is 14. In the same period last year, permanent exclusions from Craven mainstream schools represented 7.6% of the North Yorkshire total (2 of 26).


# **Absence from school**



- As of 17<sup>th</sup> December, 90.1% of all children on roll of primary schools in Craven were in attendance, a lower proportion than the North Yorkshire total (91.7%)
- The proportion of children in attendance in primary schools fell in Craven over the Winter term, down from 93.5% at 30<sup>th</sup> November (-3.4pp)
- As of 17<sup>th</sup> December, 87.0% of children in Craven secondary schools were in attendance, a higher proportion than the North Yorkshire total of 85.1%
- The proportion of children in attendance in secondary schools in Craven has decreased over the Winter term, down from 90.1% at the beginning of November to 87.0% (-3.0pp)

 As of 17<sup>th</sup> December 2020 there were 568 children recorded as being absent from mainstream schools in Craven for unauthorised absence or absence related to Covid-19, 12.9% of the 4406 recorded in North Yorkshire mainstream schools

456 (80.2%) were absent for reasons of Covid-19 in the locality, the North Yorkshire total was 3371 (76.5%)




% of children on-roll recorded as persistently absent


- The persistent absence rate for children in Craven secondary schools in the 2018/19 academic year was 12.82% This was a lower rate than North Yorkshire secondary schools as a whole, 14.33% in this period.
- The persistent absence rate for children in Craven primary schools in the 2018/19 academic year was 5.47%, similar to the 5.49% in 2017/18. This was a much lower rate than North Yorkshire primary schools as a whole, 7.45% in this period.
- Since the return to schools following closure during Covid-19 lockdown, the attendance of pupils in North Yorkshire schools is being monitored on a weekly basis.

**NB:** There have been no other absence data collections as the Summer Census was cancelled and the Autumn Census 2021 did not collect absence data either.

## **Elective Home Education**

- As of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 there were a total of 808 children recorded as being Electively Home Educated (EHE) in North Yorkshire, 67 of these were formerly in a mainstream school in Craven.
- 808 is a 30% increase on the same period in 2019. There has also been an increase for children from Craven mainstream schools in this period of +40% (48 to 67) and an increase of +46% since 2018 (46 to 67).
- A total of 265 children became EHE from mainstream schools in North Yorkshire since the start of the 2020/21 academic year, for any length of time. 29 (11%) were formerly from mainstream schools in Craven
- There has been a 115% increase (123 to 265) in North Yorkshire for EHE from mainstream schools in 2020/21 to date, when compared to the same period last year. The % increase in Craven was 171% (7 to 19)
- The figures above are for children recorded as being educated at home and not on the roll of a school.
- 0.76% is the rate of EHE of the mainstream school population in Craven as of December 2020, which is lower than
  the rate of EHE for the mainstream school population for North Yorkshire (0.99%).
- The above rate is a slight increase from 0.7% (+0.06pp) at the end of December 2019. There have been increases in EHE across all school localities in this period.
