1267: SCHOOLS CAPITAL PROGRAMME

CONSIDERED: A report providing background to the Schools Capital Programme for 2025-26 including details of priorities for investment and the Schools Condition Capital Programme.

NOTED:

- (C) The Schools Forum have identified 3 keys levels of inadequate funding and school estates is clearly 1 of the three.
- (Q) Why is there such a significant carry forward given the state of the school's premises?
- (A) This is due to a scheduling issues to implement works within the summer holidays after funding is allocated in March. We want to reassure colleagues that we work closely with property colleagues and high priority elements will be identified and where possible delivered within 25/26, if possible, or planned for 26/27. The contingency amount is for emergency unplanned items e.g. boiler breakdowns
- (A) Agreed that it should be spent and more challenge to take place to ensure that this happens, need to identify delays and what can be improved.
- (Q) Climate Action planning- this is not a separate thread?
- (A) There is work that goes on within the council and schools to look at climate action although it is challenging, within the allocation, to undertake specific climate action projects. This is due to the overall cost and associated implications example: installation of air source heat pumps vs new boilers. Note that items that are replaced have better efficiency ratings.
