Communication Support Workers

- ◆ Kirsty Basnett (based at Stepney Road Children's Home) and Hilary Curtis (based at Dovedale Children's Home) are Communication Support Workers (Speech and Language Therapists) for the No Wrong Door service
- ◆ We aim to complete a communication assessment with most of the young people who are referred to No Wrong Door
- ◆ We support young people with all aspects of communication
- ◆ We give advice about the best ways to communicate with young people depending on their needs, and advise on strategies other people can use to support the young person's communication
- ◆ We can offer advice on how to optimise a communication environment

- ◆ Ian Colpitts (based at Stepney Road Children's Home) is a Life Coach (Clinical Psychologist) for the No Wrong Door Service
- ◆ We can offer young people referred to No Wrong Door a space to talk about how they might be feeling, and to try to help them to make sense of some of the difficulties they may be experiencing. This can be a one off or on a regular basis depending on the young person's needs.
- ◆ We also offer advice and consultation to staff and carers who are supporting young people referred to No Wrong door.
- ◆ We can offer advice around assessing young people's readiness and motivation for psychological work. We can make suggestions about strategies that can be used to help young people with their emotional wellbeing.
