1.0 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 1.1 The paper provides information on options for Exceptional Element 2 (E2) budget allocations.
- 2.0 BACKGROUND
- 2.1 The Local Authority has consulted with schools and academies in Summer Term 2018 on proposals to change the way in which Exceptional E2 budget is allocated. This followed changes to the notional E2 SEN funding through the National Funding Formula. The consultation ran from 20th June to 20th July 2018 and proposed a set of new criteria and funding rates for the distribution of the funding, which effectively targeted funding at small and inclusive schools with high levels of SEN.
- 2.2 Unfortunately there was a very low response rate with only four schools returning a formal response. Following discussions at the High Needs Funding Subgroup on 10th September 2018, the Local Authority has adapted the original proposal and proposes to undertake another consultation to give schools a further opportunity for input before making a final decision.

2.0 NOTIONAL ELEMENT 2 (E2) SEN BUDGETS

- 2.1 The notional SEN budget (E2) is a proportion of a school's base funding which is "notionally" set aside for meeting the needs of children and young people with SEN attending their school. This is the same for all schools and academies.
- 2.2 The purpose of the notional SEN budget is not to provide a separate funding stream for schools and academies to meet the needs of pupils with SEN, but to provide clarity that money is incorporated into their base budgets for that purpose.
- 2.3 From their formula funding, schools and academies are expected to provide a core offer of teaching and learning for all pupils, and up to the first £6,000 of the costs of providing additional and different support to pupils with SEN. This should be aligned with the identification of children at SEN support with details of the additional support required specified in an SEN Support Plan in accordance with the SEN Code of Practice.
- 2.4 From April 2014, this £6,000 threshold has been mandatory. Whilst notional E2 funding is not ring-fenced, there is an expectation that schools and academies can account for how they have used this level of funding to meet the support needs of pupils with SEN prior to seeking additional top-up funding for that pupil. Neither should schools and academies regard the notional SEN budget as a fixed budget sum for spending. Good practice

would also include transparency in the use of this money within a school's SEN Information report on their website.

- 2.5 Following the introduction of the National Funding Formula in 2018-19, the calculation of the notional SEN percentage allocation within school and academy delegated budgets increased to 8.68% from 3.89%. In effect, this means that schools are required to provide support for more children with SEN in their establishments before they will be entitled to any additional contingency funding from the LA. It is important that school and academy leaders, governors and SENCos are aware of notional SEN budget allocations and how resources are being deployed.
- 3.0 EXCEPTIONAL E2 FUNDING
- 3.1 The Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) requires that local authorities have regard to the provision of additional funding outside the main funding formula for mainstream schools and academies on a consistent and fair basis where the number of their high needs pupils cannot be reflected adequately in their formula funding and where it would be unreasonable to expect them to pay for the costs of the first £6,000 of additional support for all high needs pupils.
- 3.2 Local authorities may also provide additional funding from their high needs block to schools that have a higher proportion of pupils with SEN, for example, for schools that have developed a particular specialism or have a strong local reputation for inclusion that means that they attract higher than average numbers of pupils with Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCPs) or pupils with SEN support needs.
- 3.3 There may also be some instances where it is debateable whether schools have sufficient money in their core budgets to meet the first £6,000 of additional support costs and where economies of scale come into play, for example in very small schools.
- 4.0 PROPOSALS FOR CHANGE REQUIRING CONSULTATION
- 4.1 Transitional Exceptional E2 funding has already been distributed to schools for the Summer Term 2018-19. Taking into account responses received during the Summer 2018 consultation period as well as feedback from the High Needs Funding Subgroup, it is proposed that the recurring Exceptional E2 budget will total £250k. Most of the budget (£200k) will be allocated as fixed amounts to individual schools at the start of the financial year; the remaining £50k will be retained as a contingency fund for significant in-year EHCP movements for small schools. In addition, the Local Authority proposes to implement one of the following three options.
- 4.2 **Option 1a** To apply the set of criteria for Exceptional E2 funding as set out in Appendix 2 as the new method of fixed allocation, starting from Autumn Term

2018-19. This option would be a recurring budget within the High Needs Block.

- 4.3 Option 1b Similarly to Option 1a, to apply the set of criteria for Exceptional E2 funding as set out in Appendix 2 as the new method of fixed allocation, starting from Autumn Term 2018-19. However, this option would be to cease funding from 1st April 2019.
- 4.4 **Option 2** To continue with the transitional funding method used for the Summer Term 2018-19 and cease funding from 1st April 2019
- 4.5 **Option 3** Allocate no further funding (i.e. effectively cease funding at the end-Summer Term 2018).
- 4.6 Indicative funding allocations at individual school level for the options 1 and 2 are shown in Appendix 1. For option 1, the August 18 to March 19 values will be updated and finalised prior to the start of the consultation with EHCP pupil counts as at 30 September 2018. The 2019-20 (April 19 to March 20) values will be updated and finalised with EHCP and SEN pupil counts gathered in the January 2019 Schools census once the data is available.
- 5.0 RECOMMENDATIONS
- 5.1 Schools Forum are asked to note the contents of the report and to note the proposal for a consultation with schools and academies on the options outlined in section 4.


