Remember: Your award letter must clearly show the name of the child, and the award period shown must also confirm the child is still eligible and being paid Disability Living allowance on headcount week of the term you are claiming for.
If your award letter does not confirm this information or is out of date, this will not be accepted, and your DAF claim cannot be paid.
