FEAST is back this Summer holiday and better than ever, with a fantastic range of activities to keep children active, fed and having fun during the school holidays. All children and young people across North Yorkshire can get involved, with free places and a free meal for eligible families, thanks to funding from the Department for Education.

If a child is eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals or is made eligible by exception (see the <u>FEAST</u> <u>FAQs</u> for details), they will receive a voucher from their school. This will enable the family to book school holiday activities that are part of the FEAST programme for free, using the online platform Holiday Activities.
