Free Autumn/Winter vaccination Webinars

In partnership with NHSE Workforce Education and Training, a free workshop is available regarding the Autumn/Winter vaccination programme for 2023/2024. We particularly wish to target participants who come into contact with low vaccine and screening uptake populations, including areas of high deprivation, ethnic minority groups, parents of 2&3 year olds and school age children, and those in at-risk categories and care home settings. The session will be interactive and include modelled conversations that showcase the core skills and processes being used. Although this is focused on winter vaccinations, these skills can be utilised for conversations about a range of other issues, for example, childhood immunisations.
