<b>Explanation of the points 1-9 in the table above</b>	
<b>1 &amp; 1a</b>	Eligible dates of birth are nationally set. Children will be eligible from the beginning of the term following their 2nd or 3rd birthday. For example; children born in the period 1st January to 31st March will become eligible for a funded place on 1st April. See sheet 2 for eligible date of birth table.
<b>2</b>	School term dates are the dates when maintained schools are open. Schools will identify the nominated training days within these dates.
<b>3</b>	Half Term Dates are the dates when maintained schools will be closed.
<b>4</b>	Number of funded weeks - The Department for Education gives the local authority funding for 38 weeks in a financial year. The funded year is April to March. Where a provider is open for longer than the termly funded weeks - the provider should use their discretion on what they do, for example; parents can be invoiced for anything over and above the funded entitlement.
<b>5</b>	Number of universal funded hours per term that all eligible children can access in the term - these can be taken during the school term or stretched*.
<b>6</b>	Number of extended entitlement funded hours per term that children can be funded for the term, these can be taken during the school term or stretched. A voucher code must have been validated to enable a claim to be made.
<b>7</b>	within each term. Each provider determines whether to offer stretched funding and chooses the number of weeks they are stretching the funding within the prescribed dates. The stretched dates from one term to the next should not overlap. Please contact the Early Years Funding Team if you decide to offer stretched funding.
<b>8</b>	Synergy FIS provider portal opens to submit the termly headcount, the portal will be available to submit headcounts until the week of headcount in each term. You will have the opportunity to check and amend your submission following the processing of headcount - date to be confirmed each term.
<b>9</b>	Headcount week - a claim can be made for children who are registered and attending the provision during this week.
