Sufficiency tab open for completion

The sufficiency tab in the FIS Provider Portal is <u>now open</u> for Autumn term 2024. The deadline for submitting your sufficiency data is Friday, 4th October 2024.

Please could <u>all</u> early years and childcare providers ensure that their sufficiency data is submitted before the deadline 4th October, including schools and wraparound providers, who are required to submit termly sufficiency information about occupancy and availability of childcare places. This is for early years (prereception) and children accessing wraparound places. The local authority has a statutory duty to ensure there are sufficient childcare places for eligible working parents and has up to date knowledge of the supply and demand of childcare places.

For government funded early years providers, completion of the sufficiency information via the Sufficiency Tab on the FIS Provider Portal is linked to the government funding monthly payment. As a government funded provider, this is referenced in the Funding Agreement section 14.4. Please ensure you complete your sufficiency data return before the deadline to ensure there are no delays in receiving your funding payments. Follow up work will be carried out for all providers who do not submit their data.

Capital Grant Funding for Early Years Childcare Expansion

Applications for Early Years Childcare Expansion Capital Grants are **now open** for all Early Years providers, including childminders, preschools, day nurseries and schools who wish to expand their current childcare offer to qualifying working parents in line with the government's expansion programme. You will have received an email on 16th July 2024 with relevant information on how to apply. **If you did not receive this email, contact us immediately on Eyexpansion@northyorks.gov.uk.** The first deadline for Early Years Capital Grant applications has now passed.

The second and final deadline for applications is Friday 15th November 2024. Please ensure you complete and submit all the necessary documents required to support your application.

Autumn term headcount - Portal is open until 4th October 2024

- ✓ The Provider Portal is open for headcount submissions please ensure you log in and submit your headcount actuals before the deadline of 4th October 2024.
- ✓ Please submit your headcount as soon as possible you can change the claim right up until the deadline, so you do not need to wait for all children's details to submit.

Revised Estimate – 6th September – 22nd September 2024

✓ The revised estimate form is now available for providers who need to amend their estimated hours. To request a link to the revised estimate form please email eyft@northyorks.gov.uk by noon Friday 20th September.

Stretched Funding

✓ All providers who chose to stretch the government funded hours offer are reminded they must make the Early Years Funding Team aware of their decision. Where there are queries regarding funded hours, the system can be configured to show us which provider offers the stretched entitlement. Change of ownership/bank accounts/Ofsted Registration No.

✓ Providers must give as much notice as possible where there are changes in ownership, or bank accounts; failure to inform the local authority will impact on future payments.

Charging

✓ Your government funded offer must be clear to enable parents to make informed choices for childcare at your setting. Invoices must be easy for parents to understand and the government funded hours must show, this will ensure you comply with the statutory guidance, as stated in section A1.30 Charging in this document - Early education and childcare (applies from 1 April 2024) - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)
