The **Unlocking SEND in the Early Years Accredited Programme** will equip an early years SENCO to ensure that their setting fulfils its responsibilities under the SEND Code of Practice 2014.

Our unique modular design and timeframe has been designed especially with our early years providers in mind. Unlike some other early years SEND courses participants are able to choose when to complete their accreditation provided that it is within three years from the first course start date.

For example;

1. Commence first module, US-EYs: The SENCO Role, in October 2021, complete the three other modules by July 2022
2. Commence the first module in October 2021, complete another module in 2022, complete a third and fourth module before July 2024

The first module must be US-EYs:The SENCO Role but the other modules can be completed in any order.

This means that if a participant has a break from work, for any reason such as pregnancy, accident or injury leading to extended time off, change in workplace, their progress towards the award will not be adversely affected even if that break is unplanned. Additionally if a setting is funding an employee to attend this course, our flexible design can take into account fluctuating financial circumstances.
