Applications for Early Years Childcare Expansion Capital Grants are **now open** for all Early Years providers, including childminders, preschools, day nurseries and schools who wish to expand their current childcare offer to qualifying working parents in line with the government's expansion programme. You will have received an email on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2024 with relevant information on how to apply. **If you did not receive this email, contact us immediately on Eyexpansion@northyorks.gov.uk**. The first deadline for Early Years Capital Grant applications is Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2024.

There will a second deadline in November for Early Years Capital Grant applications those providers who are not able to complete their application by 20<sup>th</sup> September 2024.

#### Sufficiency tab open for completion

The sufficiency tab in the FIS Provider Portal is <u>now open</u> for Autumn term 2024. The deadline for submitting your sufficiency data is Friday, 4<sup>th</sup> October 2024.

ALL early years and childcare providers, including schools and wraparound providers, are required to submit termly sufficiency information about occupancy and availability of childcare places. This is for early years (pre-reception) and children accessing wraparound places. The local authority has a statutory duty to ensure there are sufficient childcare places for eligible working parents. With the government's proposed expansion of early years provision including school-based nursery provision, it is essential the local authority has up to date knowledge of the supply and demand of places within the current childcare market.

For government funded early years providers, completion of the sufficiency information via the Sufficiency Tab on the FIS Provider Portal is linked to the government funding monthly payment. As a government funded provider, this is referenced in the Funding Agreement section 14.4. Please ensure you complete your sufficiency data return before the deadline to ensure there are no delays in receiving your funding payments. Follow up work will be carried out for all providers who do not submit their data.

# Early Years Funding

## **Early Years Funding**

# Autumn term headcount - Portal is open until 4th October 2024

- ✓ Claims for Working Parent Entitlement have the same conditions for all age groups.
- ✓ Entitlement codes must have a <u>start date on or before 31<sup>st</sup> August</u> and <u>end date must be</u> <u>on or after 1<sup>st</sup> September 2024</u> for all eligible children.
  - Example, if the code end date is 17<sup>th</sup> August parent has not reconfirmed then you will not be able to submit the claim.
- ✓ Working Parent entitlement codes do not change but the parent must continue to reconfirm by the code end date.
- ✓ If a 2-year-old has an NYC 6-digit code **and** a working parent 11-digit code, then you should use the NYC 6-digit code until the term after the child's 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday. The parent must continue to reconfirm their working parent entitlement 11-digit code in readiness for term after the child has their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday.
- ✓ Do not wait until October to submit your headcount; you can change the claim right up until the end of headcount week -4<sup>th</sup> October 2024.

## Revised Estimate – 6<sup>th</sup> September – 19<sup>th</sup> September 2024

✓ You will be able to provide a revised estimate in September if you missed the estimate deadline, or your numbers are different to the estimate, please look out for the email that will be sent to all providers on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2024, to revise estimates you must reply to the email, and you will receive the link to the Revised Estimate Online Form. Please note it will be a provider's responsibility to reply to the email sent on 6<sup>th</sup> September and then complete the Revised Estimate Online Form using the link.

#### **Two Factor Authentication**

## **New Staff**

- ✓ Please ensure new staff are aware of what is required with regards to Early Years Funding and have the relevant system access. <u>Early Years Funding New Staff Information 2024-</u> 2025.pdf (northyorks.gov.uk)
- ✓ Access to systems for staff who have left must be managed appropriately.

## Change of ownership/bank accounts

✓ Providers must give as much notice as possible where there are changes in ownership, or bank accounts; failure to inform the local authority will impact on future payments.

## Charging

✓ Your government funded offer must be clear to enable parents to make informed choices for childcare at your setting. Invoices must be easy for parents to understand and the government funded hours must show, this will ensure you comply with the statutory guidance, as stated in section A1.30 Charging in this document - Early education and childcare (applies from 1 April 2024) - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)
