Wraparound Childcare Revenue Grant Funding

Wraparound Childcare Revenue Grant Funding is available for schools and providers looking to create a new provision or expand existing provision to meet the DfE requirements for wraparound childcare. Funding is available until 31st March 2026 and the **final opportunity to apply is 30th January 2026.** <u>Schools and providers are encouraged to apply for funding as soon as possible.</u>

The Round 7 application deadline is 19th September 20025. It is anticipated that applicants will be informed of the revenue grant funding decision by 10th October 2025.

To apply for Wraparound Childcare Revenue Grant Funding, please read the attached Application Guidance document. Links to the online application forms can be found within the guidance. All applicants must also submit the attached Supporting Evidence Checklist and associated documents, as well as a signed Application Declaration (attached).

Disadvantage Two-Year-Old Codes – (Families in Receipt of Additional Support)

Please note that once codes are issued for two-year old children of families in receipt of additional support (also known as Disadvantage Two Year Old Funding), parents **do not** need to reconfirm every 3 months. These codes remain valid until the child becomes eligible for Universal 15 hours funding.

Visitors to the current Childcare Choices website will automatically be diverted to the new Best Start in Life website for a transitional period. ESTIMATES NOW CLOSED - Autumn Term Estimates

- ✓ If you have <u>not</u> submitted an estimate, you will be contacted via email but will <u>not</u> receive a payment in September.
- ✓ If you need to update your estimates because they have changed considerably, please contact eyft@northyorks.gov.uk for further instructions.

HEADCOUNT OPEN NOW Autumn Term Headcount – Deadline 3rd October 2025

- ✓ All providers should submit Autumn term headcount do not wait until headcount week as amendments/additions can always be done up until the deadline.
- ✓ All schools with early years headcount submission must be the same as that on the census.
- ✓ Headcount week 29th September 3rd October 2025
- ✓ DAF evidence must be submitted by 3rd October 2025

REMINDER Funding is for 14 weeks

✓ Term Time only providers should manage the shortfall in funded weeks in Autumn term and make parents aware of how they have decided to manage this. As explained in Useful dates 2025-2026.pdf

REMINDER Invoices must comply with the statutory quidance

- ✓ Please use the guidance <u>Early education and childcare GOV.UK</u> Section 1.32 to ensure parents are aware of your charges
- ✓ Refundable deposit can be requested to cover costs incurred if a child leaves before headcount

IMPORTANT - Using the Eligibility Checker on the Portal

- ✓ Parents must hold a valid code from HMRC with a start date on or before 31st August 2025 and end date on or after 1st September 2025 to access all types of Working Family funding from September 2025.
- ✓ An amber coloured banner on screen does not mean a code is valid to claim funding. Further guidance on checking codes can be found via our website here: <u>Early Education</u> Places, Funding and Entitlement | CYPSinfo

REMINDER – Providers offering stretched funding

- ✓ If you are a provider offering stretched funding, you must inform the Early Years Funding Team via email if you haven't already
- ✓ You must ensure parents understand the how the funded hours are offered on a stretched basis

You must indicate which children are accessing stretched funding when submitting headcount actuals.
