OFSTED WILL COMPLETE REMOTE INSPECTIONS OF SCHOOLS FROM 25 JANUARY

All planned inspection activity will be undertaken remotely until after February half term. Remote inspections of schools will begin from January 25 with a "particular focus on how well children and learners are being educated remotely", Ofsted said. They will be releasing details of their inspection process shortly.
