## GUIDANCE FOR STAFF TESTING IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS, SCHOOL-BASED NURSERIES AND MAINTAINED NURSERY

### SCHOOLS

Primary schools (including school-based nurseries) should expect to receive a delivery of home testing kits either this week or in the first half of next week. If you have not received your delivery by Wednesday 27 January, please contact the DfE coronavirus (COVID-19) helpdesk on 0800 046 8687. Please also call the helpline, not the delivery companies, if you have any other enquiries about your delivery. We are planning to begin deliveries to maintained nursery schools from week commencing 1 February.

Guidance has now been published for [testing primary, school-based nursery and maintained nursery school staff](#) to support you with this. Home testing of staff in primary schools (including school-based nurseries) can begin from week commencing Monday 25 January once schools have received and distributed kits to staff.

**Succession planning: preparing your board for the future**

**3 February 2021 6.00pm – 8.00pm**

In order to support governing boards in developing and planning future leadership, the NGA will be hosting a webinar for North Yorkshire governors on 3 February 2021 starting at 6:00pm.

This interactive session will be based on NGA's guidance to support succession planning, and will cover topics such as establishing a culture of succession, using a succession cycle, developing governors and ensuring leadership of the board. The workshop will explore what good chairing looks like, the barriers to succession and ways to overcome the common barriers. Every delegate will receive a hard copy of NGA's publication 'Preparing your board for the future'

The aims of the session are to:

- understand the importance and principles of succession planning
- define an effective culture for succession
- reflect on barriers to succession and develop a succession strategy.

Whilst the primary target audience is chairs, the session is suitable for any governors, trustees, local governors and clerks because succession planning is a board responsibility.
