School Funding 2018-19

Audience: all schools

Following the recent consultation on school funding, the North Yorkshire Education Partnership (Schools Forum) met last week (13 December) to make its final recommendations to the Council. A full set of the papers can be found at: http://cyps.northyorks.gov.uk/nyep-meetings-and-agendas

As can be seen, there was considerable support for the proposals set out in that consultation. 91% of those responding agreed with the move to the NFF as a basis for funding next year, while 79% agreed to use a Minimum Funding Guarantee of 0%. 72% agreed with the proposal to use up to 0.5% of the additional funding next year to support pressures in the High Needs Block

In line with the views expressed at the consultation, the final recommendations were:

- That North Yorkshire uses the values set out in the DfE's National Funding Formula, including the various transitional arrangements, and a Minimum Funding Guarantee of 0%, as a basis for funding schools in 2018-19
- To agree that up to 0.5% of the Schools Block can be used to support High Needs and that a further report is brought back to the Partnership/Forum in due course reporting on how we will use this funding and also any support from other sources, such as reserves.

These recommendations will be put forward to the Council's Executive in January for formal approval.

In the meantime, officers will – once we have final data from DfE which is expected by 21st December – begin work to model school budget allocations. We expect to be able to send final budget allocations to schools around February half-term.
