Advice regarding bomb threats.

Audience: All schools

Following a series of malicious hoax communications to schools across the UK, which are not being investigated as terrorism related offences, it is important that you are alert, but not alarmed.

Please <u>CLICK HERE</u> to be taken to the School Emergency Response Guide <u>pages</u> on bomb threats. (you may need to be logged in for this) Here you will find guidance on how to act if you do get any calls /emails/ social media contact of this nature.

Action required: <u>CLICK HERE to view Police statement</u>, follow guidance above, and inform Police first if you receive any communications of this sort.

Permanently Excluded Pupils and School Performance Tables

Audience: secondary schools

Action required: Headteachers and senior leaders to be aware that when you take a key stage 4 pupil that has been permanently excluded from another school onto your roll, that pupil and their results can be discounted from, and therefore not impact upon, your school's performance tables. It is hoped that clarification of this fact will also support inclusive practice within local behaviour collaboratives.

Last year North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service saw a spike in deliberate fires over the Easter holidays and we'd like to see a reduction in those numbers this year.

Parents can help us with this by checking on their children's plans and keeping matches and lighters somewhere that isn't easily accessible.

Deliberately starting fires is against the law, and even small fires can endangers lives. Fire spreads quickly and can be unpredictable.
