The DFE have sent the following guidance in relation to protected status for those pupils with eligibility for free school meals (FSM). Please note the LA has addressed all errors in <u>maintained schools</u> that relate to FSM as a result of the changes mentioned below and all errors have been resolved. Academy Schools may need to login to Collect and check if the changes to FSM eligibility has resulted in any errors and may need to amend details for those pupils as per the guidance below. For academy schools using North Yorkshire to check the FSM claims please check the SAM module.

'IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Please note, the following applies to all local authorities and not only those authorities currently in the process of rolling out the universal credit.

There still seems to be some confusion around the recording of FSM eligibility. To clarify, following the introduction of universal credit on 1 April 2018, a pupil's FSM status will be protected until the end of the universal credit roll out period i.e. 31 March 2022, or until their phase of education at that time ends
