What is DLD?

- DLD stands for Developmental Language Disorder (previously known as Specific Language Impairment)
- It is when a child or young person has severe, persistent difficulties with understanding and using language
- DLD is the term used where there is no other cause for the difficulties, such as Autism or neurological impairment

Top tips:

- Give the child or young person time to think, find their words and respond
- Use simple language with the key words they need to learn
- Keep sentences short and concise
- Concentrate on the knowledge you want them to learn and simplify the rest

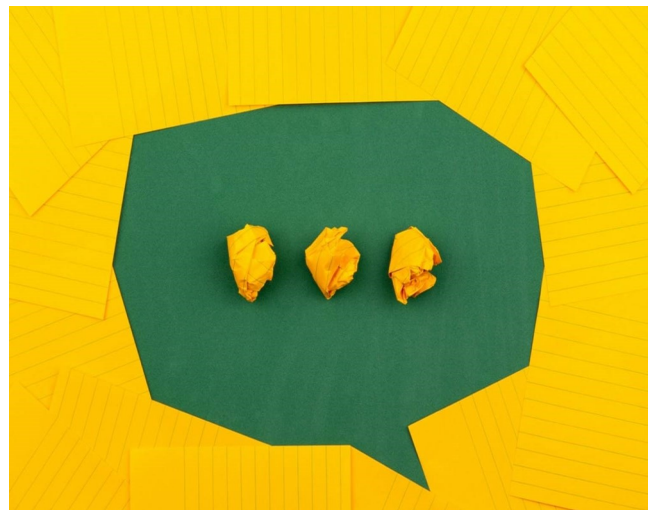
