Healthy Schools Virtual Pupil Celebration Event On Tuesday 22nd June 1-3pm via Zoom

- Free for all schools, including academies, to attend remotely.
- An event for pupils to attend to enable them to be an active part of healthy schools work in your school.
- An opportunity for pupils to learn more about the healthy schools award and find out some effective ways they can promote health and wellbeing in school.
- Pupils can take part in two live interactive upper KS2 primary or secondary workshops based around the Healthy Schools themes:
 - o Active Lives find out how to increase activity throughout the school day
 - o Emotional health & wellbeing what works well to increase pupil wellbeing
 - o Food in schools explore ways of increasing healthier eating in school
 - o Pupil voice develop ideas for improving pupil voice in your school

NB you will be emailed in advance to choose two workshops but all workshops and key speaker sessions will be recorded and available to watch again after the live event.

- You must register to take part in the Healthy Schools award scheme to attend. The
 Healthy Schools award scheme is fully funded by North Yorkshire Public Health for all
 schools to take part, including academies, with free training and support. Register

- Pupils must be accompanied by an adult who can write in the chat box during the
 event. There is no limit on how many pupils can take part from your school but they
 will need to be able to see a screen to view the event. We suggest you connect via a
 whiteboard or for small groups of pupils to work around different laptops/ ipads.
- Please only book one place per school. You can use the Zoom login, which will be emailed to your school in advance of the event by Mondale events, on multiple devices if you want different groups of pupils to take part.

Workshops will be delivered by our partners: NYCC Catering, North Yorkshire Sport, NYCC Pupil Voice and the Healthy Schools team. Council Directors and Councillors will be speaking at the event.
