North Yorkshire Fire & Rescue Service have recently launched a few safety and educational programmes that I would like to make you aware of.

- **Key stage 1 fire safety** – a new and exciting home fire safety related presentation aimed to teach the fire service motto – Get out, Stay Out, Get the fire service out.
- **Key stage 2 fire safety** – A fresh look at fire hazards for young people and how to keep safe when at home or at school.
- **Key stage 3 fire safety** – a new and interactive workshop which looks at deliberate fire setting, hoax calls and peer pressure.

Key stage 5 road safety – Our new pre driver workshop aimed at 16 to 18 year olds where we raise awareness for the Fatal 5

1. Driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs
2. Speeding
3. Seatbelts
4. Using a mobile phone
5. Careless driving

This workshop is brand new and aims to teach about the ripple effect, boundaries, how to make a 999 call and self-preservation.
