

Leading Behaviour Change: A one-day conference exclusively for Head teachers and senior leaders in primary schools across North Yorkshire

The local authority is hosting a one day conference facilitated by Pivotal Education as part of our continued drive to further build expertise in schools and reduce exclusions. This organisational behaviour change model creates measurable change in behaviour and learning built on the development of positive relationships.

The conference will cover:

3. Understand why managing staff behaviour is your first priority.
4. Create a 'Behaviour Blueprint' to form the bridge between behaviour policy and practice in your school.
