THE RULES

- 1. Lifestyle is open to young people who live in the North Yorkshire Police area or attend school in the county.
- 2. Every entrant must be aged between 10 and 17 years old on August 31st 2019
- Teams can be made up of 2-6 people (which includes the adult advisor) You do not have to be at the same school. Teams cannot be made up entirely of young people whose parents/guardians work for North Yorkshire Police.
- T-shirts will only be issued to the first 100 young people to register as part of a team.
- Only work carried out between 15th July 2019 and 8th September 2019 will be taken into consideration during the judging process.

- 6. If after registration, a member of the team leaves, the team can carry on providing there are at least 2 members left. The Lifestyle Office must be told of any changes and new member details. A person can only be a member of one team at a time.
- 7. All Log Books must be sent to the Lifestyle Office, Partnership Hub, North Yorkshire Police, I 'Anson Road, Richmond, North Yorkshire DL10 4ND, clearly marked "LIFESTYLE" by the 22nd September 2019 for judging. Those received after 30th September 2019 will not be eligible for judging.
- 8. Any prize is for the team members only and is not transferable or negotiable.
- For the activity holiday the team members will need to be accompanied/ supervised by an adult throughout their stay.
- The decision of the Lifestyle Project Coordinator and the judges is final. No discussion or correspondence will be entered into.
