



North Yorkshire County Council/Pathfinder Teaching School Hub Appropriate Body & Early Career Framework Services 2022-3

From September 2022, North Yorkshire County Council (NYCC) and Pathfinder Teaching School Hub (PTSH) will be working in partnership to deliver Appropriate Body (AB) services. This collaboration will ensure the continuation of high-standards and quality support, as well as creating increased capacity in the system. This will provide stability for schools and their early career teachers (ECTs) moving forward. Our aim remains that ECTs registered with NYCC and PTSH successfully complete their ECT induction period.

Delivering our shared statutory duty through established resilient systems, we will ensure that all children have quality education whether in maintained or academy schools. This collaborative partnership will ultimately benefit all children, from all backgrounds and abilities within our region, giving them a "World Class start in life".

As a partnership we will continue to support early career teachers and schools as part of the statutory ECT induction delivery process. In partnership we will provide Appropriate Body services for schools within the Teaching School Hub area, for schools in their cross-border MATs, and for prominent trusts based in neighbouring local authority areas.

Collaboration underpins the ethos of both the North Yorkshire Appropriate Body and the Pathfinder Teaching School Hub as we serve schools across our region. Our joint mission is to provide early career teachers with the best possible start to their careers.

Impact on schools:

For 2022-3 there are no proposed changes to pricing or the approach taken to delivering Appropriate Body services.

We will continue to ensure that:

- Schools provide adequate support for ECTs
- ECT assessment is fair and consistent
- The Early Career Framework (ECF) is being delivered

Our ECT Support Service

We will continue to deliver comprehensive support through the induction programme including:

- Welcome meetings for all ECTs, Guidance on the statutory induction process
- Free support and training from Induction Coordinator and Mentors

- Induction Coordinator updates
- In-school support
- Administration support and guidance if required
- Reminders of when each progress review and formal assessment is due

Cost of our ECT Support Service

For 2022-3 the cost of both the North Yorkshire AB and the Pathfinder Teaching School Hub AB service is £100 plus VAT per ECT per year, on the PTSH Full Induction Programme (FIP). Please note that Core Induction Programme (CIP) or School-led (SL) visits or fidelity checks may incur additional costs. During the academic year 2022-3, NYCC will be reviewing and reducing their Appropriate Body services and more information on this will follow during the 2022-3 academic year. This will be informed by the national review of Appropriate Body services following the publication of the Schools White Paper. The national review will take place in summer 2022 and confirmation of future arrangements will be confirmed following the completion of this review.

Legacy ECTs

For 2022-3, Legacy ECTs (those who began their induction before September 2021) will remain with NYCC to complete their induction using the old systems and paperwork.

How to register your ECTs with an Appropriate Body

Year 2 ECTS (both part and full time) already registered with NYCC can remain with us. There is no need to complete a new ECT registration form but could you please confirm the names of Year 2 ECTs remaining with you by June 30th 2022 on Schoolimprovementservice@northyorks.gov.uk

Any Legacy ECTs will remain with NYCC and are not required to be re-registered.

Year 1 ECTs who will begin their induction from September 2022 should register with Pathfinder Teaching School Hub on <u>https://forms.gle/vhjwdGHDQpLSphe68</u>. PTSH will then contact you to discuss next steps. This form can be used to both register for AB services and also to confirm enrollment on the Ambition Full Induction Programme.
