Dear Colleagues,

I am writing to inform you of a number of developments in relation to the work of the North Yorkshire Safeguarding Children Partnership (NYSCP) and how we are looking to move forward with and work closer with schools and particularly the Designated Safeguarding Leads (DSL) in the future.

From this term the NYSCP is coordinating the delivery of DSL Updates previously delivered through the North Yorkshire County Council's, School Improvement Service. The next North Yorkshire DSL Network Meeting will be held on 15 July 2022 and will explore:

- Developing DSL Gaps
- School Attendance
- Changes to the NYCC Safeguarding Team
- The latest NYSCP Updates

As part of the new structure for the updates we are also introducing a new 30 minute section dedicated for new DSLs to ensure they are aware of the key information they need to undertake their role.

The new DSL Updates will take place online on a termly basis and will be open to <u>all</u> primary, secondary and special schools and PRUs in North Yorkshire (i.e. maintained, academies, and independent). DSLs will be able to book their places with for each session through the NYSCP website (<u>www.safeguardingchildren.co.uk/training-north-yorkshire/training-courses/</u>).

In order to improve communications directly with schools we are also looking to create a directory of DSL contact emails. Given the number of schools in North Yorkshire and staff involved, it is impractical to keep an up to date list as this will constantly be subject to change due to staff mobility. Therefore, I would be grateful if your school would create a dedicated "DSL" email forwarding address (e.g. <u>DSL@youschoolname.domain</u>) to ensure that the NYSCP can send regular updates directly to DSLs. **Please note that the "DSL" email address should be redirected to your DSL's email account by your school if and when your DSL changes**.

When your DSL email address has been set up, please complete the short snap survey to confirm your school details. **Please complete this by the 30 June 2022**.

We are currently reviewing the changes to the document and will be updating the School Child Protection Manual and Template Policy for adoption by schools.

We are also planning the next NYSCP School Safeguarding Audit for 2022/2023 commencing in the autumn term. Our short snap survey also includes some questions to assist in this process. Further details about the audit will be provided in due course.
