Supporting Your School

Any school can request support from an English Hub. However, if there is more demand than capacity, hubs will select schools to support based on the school's capacity to improve, the level of the need for support and the level of disadvantage of the children at the school.

The support the English Hub can provide includes:

- Two free places per school at Showcase events, including a contribution towards supply cover costs
- A minimum of one place on any of our training courses
- A free full day audit of your school's early language and reading provision carried out by one of our Literacy Specialists and support with action planning
- Up to 9 days of school-to-school support led by one of our experienced Literacy Specialists





Audits

What is an audit?

Unlock Powerful Insights: Our one-day phonics program audits provide a clear picture of your school's current strengths and areas for growth. This valuable assessment helps you identify what's working well and pinpoint opportunities to elevate your phonics instruction to new heights.

Expert Guidance at Your Fingertips: Throughout the process, you'll benefit from the insights of a DfE-trained Literacy Specialist. These experts offer tailored advice and support to ensure you develop a practical action plan with achievable next steps towards phonics teaching excellence.

Streamlined Process, Meaningful Impact: Our audits are designed to be efficient, typically taking just one day to complete depending on your school size. Furthermore, eligible schools can claim £100 to cover the time of your Reading/Phonics Leader involved in the process.

What to expect in an audit

Collaborative Kick-off: We'll begin with a conversation with your school leadership team to understand your specific priorities and any self-assessment information you've already gathered. This ensures the audit is tailored to your unique needs.

Classroom Insights: Together with your Early Reading/Phonics Leader and SLT, we'll observe phonics and reading instruction firsthand through a learning walk. This allows us to see your program in action and identify areas of strength.

Learning Environment Assessment: We'll also take a close look at your early reading learning environments and resources. This helps us ensure your physical space and materials support effective phonics instruction.

Strengths & Opportunities Discussion: Following the observations, we'll have a collaborative discussion to highlight your current strengths and pinpoint areas for development in your phonics program.

Actionable Roadmap: Together, we'll create a clear action plan with specific, achievable steps your school can take to achieve phonics teaching excellence.

Continued Support: Our commitment doesn't end with the audit. We'll schedule a follow-up call to discuss your progress on the action plan and offer ongoing support.


