New SENCo training (suitable for Primary and Secondary but not early years)

Outline

This course is intended for teachers who are new to the role of SENCo.

Description

The induction will include:

- Developing the role of the SENCo to enable you to become an effective leader of SEND by managing the operational and strategic aspects of the role successfully.
- Who is who and who does what in North Yorkshire –where and how to obtain help and support.
- A focus on Chapter 6 of the SEN Code of Practice and the Graduated Response including looking at 'Assess Plan Do Review'.
- An SEN journey from early identification of SEND to conducting annual reviews. Taking you through the processes and required paperwork.
- What does SEN look like in your school/setting? Sharing best practice around what processes and procedures are in place, and what provision is available.
- Signposting to where to obtain the wealth of information available to help you undertake your role. PowerPoints and other materials will be made available to you.

Outcome

As a result of attending, delegates should:

- Understand the role and responsibilities of the SENCo including how to monitor effectively.

- Know how to make the best provision in school for pupils with SEND, in line with latest legislation, particularly the SEN Code of Practice.
- Be able to identify CYP with SEN and understand the Assess, Plan, Do and Review process of the Graduated Response.
- Understand what the provision is available within the authority and make appropriate referrals.
- Understand the processes from early identification of SEN to conducting annual reviews
