Changes to Educational Provision from September

- Pupil Referral Services: Transformation into Alternative Provision without the need for Permanent Exclusion
- Targeted Provision – Year 1 Roll Out of Schools
- The establishment of SEND Multi-disciplinary Hubs in localities
- The Medical Education Service
- Area Inclusion Panels
- Support for primary children at risk or having been permanently excluded
