Free School Meal Eligibility Checks

As you will be aware following the introduction of the National Funding Formula (NFF) there have been changes in the way schools are funded.

One of the changes from April 2019 will be that the funding for assessing Free School Meal (FSM) Eligibility will no longer be de delegated by the local authority. This means that all schools will be responsible for processing and checking the entitlement of pupils to free school meals.

The local authority currently provides a Free School Meal Assessment (FSMA) Service as a traded service to academies and we are extending this to all schools from April 2019.

The support available as a traded service will include:

- Processing new applications for free school meals
- Processing Key Stage1 applications to determine economic entitlement to FSM
- o Verifying if a pupil is eligible or not to free school meals using the ECS

(The ECS is a Department for Education system which automatically checks data from Department for Works & Pensions (DWP), Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs (HMRC) and the Home Office. LA's use this system to check eligibility for free school meals electronically ensuring the process is more accurate and efficient)

- o Informing parents of eligibility or otherwise
- Providing the school with access to SAM (Schools Access Module) to view information relating to free FSM eligibility
- Following up Proof of benefits where required and the investigation of any suspected fraudulent applications.
- Advice and support on all aspects of free school meal enquiries

## The cost of the service for 2019/20 is £9 per pupil per successful application.
