The pupil can:	
<ul> <li>read accurately by blending the sounds in words that contain the common graphemes for all 40+ phonemes *</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>read accurately some words of two or more syllables that contain the same grapheme-phoneme correspondences*</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>read many common exception words*</li> </ul>	
In a book closely matched to the GPCs as above, the pupil can:	
<ul> <li>read aloud many words quickly and accurately without overt sounding and blending</li> </ul>	
sound out many unfamiliar words accurately	
In discussion with the teacher, the pupil can:	
<ul> <li>answer questions and make inferences on the basis of what is being said and done in a familiar book that is read to them</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>read accurately most words of two or more syllables</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>read most words containing common suffixes*</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>read most common exception words*</li> </ul>	
In age appropriate books, the pupil can:	
<ul> <li>read words accurately and fluently without overt sounding and blending eg at over 90 words per minute</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>sound out most unfamiliar words accurately, without undue hesitation</li> </ul>	
In a familiar book that they can already read accurately and fluently, the pupil can:	
check it makes sense to them	
<ul> <li>answer questions and make some inferences on the basis of what is being said and done</li> </ul>	

WORKING AT GREATER DEPTH WITHIN THE EXPECTED STANDARD	More Evidence Needed state 'yes' if required
The pupil can, in a book that they are reading independently:	
<ul> <li>make inferences on the basis of what is said and done</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>predict what might happen on the basis of what has been read so far</li> </ul>	
make links between the book they are reading and other books they have read
