Dear Headteacher

The EAL and GRT service has recently undergone a restructure and from September will be based in NYCC offices, rather than schools.

The service supports teachers to develop their skills and strategies so they can effectively support EAL and GRT pupils in the mainstream classroom. The service also offers bespoke support for new arrivals with little or no English, to help them make rapid progress so they can access the curriculum and can help liaise with non-English speaking parents. Support is also available for EAL pupils with SATs and GCSE preparation.

The EAL and GRT Consultants from September will be:

- Sue Wadsworth: Hambleton and Selby

The Core offer

From September 2018 to Easter 2019, the service will be offering the following core offer: **EAL and/ or GRT Health Check (No cost to maintained schools)** An EAL and/or GRT needs analysis visit from an EAL/GRT Consultant

The two hour session will evaluate:

- the school environment and how it celebrates diversity
- provision for EAL/GRT pupils
- teaching and learning strategies
- policies and practice
- Schools will receive a summary report and a suggested action plan.

Other schools, such as academies, independent schools and schools beyond North Yorkshire can purchase a health check for £240

Support for pupils who are part of the Refugee Resettlement Programme:

- 1:1, small group or in class support, as appropriate.
- Delivered by an EAL Advanced Teaching Assistant
- Up to 10 sessions of up to 1 hour per year, based on need. Additional sessions can be purchased
- For maintained schools and academies.
